ocated within an iconic early-1900s heritage building in the Sydney CBD, this one-bedroom apartment speaks of luxury and sophistication and offers a bright, vibrant and masculine palette of contemporary interiors.

Bespoke finishes integrated the client's extensive art collection and the "wow impact" brief, resulting in a grand, spacious living environment that complements the apartment's original features.

The client, a single 60-year-old male, has worked in the interior design industry for more than 30 years, importing lighting products and furniture. The apartment he presented to interior designer Amgad Kamel, of AK Interiors, featured a '90s-style interior with carpet and standard finishes and furnishings. After renting out the apartment for 10 years, the client was ready to renovate it to live in for his retirement. "His brief of wow interiors reflecting luxury and bright, vibrant interiors directed the design concept," says Amgad.

Two bedrooms were converted into one, with a spacious, inviting entry foyer and dining space adjoining the living area. "I love every part of the design, however my standout is the foyer for its simplicity yet sophisticated impact," reveals Amgad.

An open living space offers perfectly proportioned ceiling heights and the existing windows allow a vast amount of natural light through the whole space.

Textured grass wallpaper, silk wall panels, timber wall panels and white-painted walls work perfectly as the backdrop for the vibrant blue, gold and white soft furnishings. The furniture's colour palette of dark chocolate, gloss black and inlaid designs

delivers the touch of glamour and luxury required for the space. Standout upholstered furniture pieces add the punch of colour required to complete the design. Bespoke furniture pieces were selected and designed to stand as individual pieces and to form a successful marriage with all other soft furnishing elements, textures and finishes.

The client's extensive art collection including works by David Bromley, Robert Dickerson and David Boyd set the bar for a contemporary, luxury interior with layers of elegance and sophistication. The collection was utilised as the backdrop on every wall to deliver visual interest and talking points without being lost to the extravagant, vibrant furnishings.

Recycled oak timber boards throughout the apartment replace the existing tiled floor and the use of pre-finished Black Japan stain forms a balanced contrast against the vivid white walls and trimmings. Laying the timber in a herringbone pattern achieves design impact and makes the space visually larger.

Recycled floor coverings, energy-efficient lighting and upholstered wall panels with a visually stunning textured surface make up a healthy, sustainable interior with long-term durability.

The finished design delivers a classic contemporary interior that is decorative and a living environment that reflects the client's lifestyle and love of travel and entertaining.
